MONACO DISEASE POWER is a registered charity under Monegasque law constituted on 15 June 2007 and accredited by the Prince's Government in accordance with Act No 1.355 of 23 December 2008

HSH Prince Albert II acts as its Honorary Chairman.

The objectives of Monaco Disease Power are to:

- inform, represent and bring together the parents or legal guardians of children or adults who are mentally or physically disabled or suffering from mental illnesses;
- to inform and communicate with eminent figures, government authorities and the public on this issue and the actions taken now or in the future to help the patients mentioned in the paragraph above, notably to help them integrate into society;
- to provide material and financial support to all organisations or charities, in the Principality or abroad, which work with children who are mentally or physically disabled or suffering from mental illnesses. Aid may also be provided directly to families with mentally disabled children or adults;
- to finance, alone or in collaboration with other charities or institutes, one or more care centres and in general, manage shared projects.

OBJECTIVE

In 2008, Monaco Disease Power opened a new outdoor pursuits centre specifically for the Principality. Its goal is to care for mentally disabled and autistic children and young adults, it operates as a day care centre on Wednesday afternoons, Saturdays and during the holidays and whenever the specialised institutions are closed. The outdoor pursuits centre is not a childcare centre but a real place of learning, where their socio-educational needs are met. Here, they are welcomed in a special setting, while still remaining fully open to others.

OPERATIONS

The centre is managed by specialised staff, supervised by Mrs Audrey Monreale, manager of the Handi'Cadre centre. It still has the support of Professor Catherine Barthélemy, our medical adviser

The number of days the centre is open has once again increased this year, especially during the summer holidays when 20 days have been programmed.

On Wednesday afternoons, 7 young people attend regularly; On average, there are 12 to 14 young people during the holiday periods. In general, there is one staff member for every young person.

In parallel, every school holiday (i.e., four times a year), the charity now organises holidays at 'La Masion d'Amélie.' For these stays, groups are restricted to 7 young people, together with 6 to 7 staff.

The cost of the annual membership for Wednesday afternoons was set at €230.

The cost for a day during the holiday periods is €38 compared to €37 last year.

These financial contributions help to pay for management costs, meals, activities and snacks.

In 2018, the total revenue of the outdoor pursuits centre amounted to €39,228 (contributions from families, advances and grants for the accommodation costs). The expenses related to the management costs and activities amounted to €92,771.

Other than the parents' contribution, all the operating costs are funded by donations

THE ACTIVITIES

Thanks to the help and kindness of its many partners, this centre offers a wide range of varied and dynamic activities: swimming pool, ice skating, rambling, museums, amusement fairs, Christmas markets, carnivals, manual activities; Cooking workshops are also regularly held.

This year, the young people took part in a sculpture workshop led by Jean François Bollié.

Catechism sessions have been set up by the Diocese of Monaco.



Since 2015, they are held every Wednesday afternoon with Sister Marie des Anges and the catechism team.

The young people at the outdoor pursuits centre are always received very warmly at the different events which take place in the Principality. They therefore experienced the magic of the circus and attended a performance of the Monaco International Circus Festival. They took part in basketball and rugby workshops with the Monaco Basketball Association and the Federation Monegasque de Rugby.

As with previous years, 15 young people participated in the Sainte Dévote Challenge and were able to take part in a rugby workshop with the help of the young players of the Federation who initiated them into this team sport.

Also, on 15 November with the help of our faithful partner, the company Telis, Monaco Disease Power brought together 100 disabled young people and their companions who were therefore able to participate in the prestigious No Finish Line event. Like every year, they were accompanied by 50 pupils from the school of St Joseph de Beausoleil.

The following institutes were also involved, Mas de l'Oustaou, I.M.E. Corniche Fleurie, I.M.E. Rossetti, I.M.E. les Terrasses and Institut Clément Ader.

This annual event ended with a wonderful dinner provided by the charity.

Monaco Disease Power has once again, this year contributed to funding the various socio-educational activities for the Bariquand Alphan Institute (judo, sea donkeys) and various grants for some families.

THE CONCEPT:

The 'Maison d'Amélie' was inaugurated on July 20, 2013; This pilot care centre is entirely focussed on caring for disabled people, their families, as well as their caregivers have fulfilled many needs.

The positive reception for this centre with an accommodation capacity for 20 people, is down to a combination of elements:

On the one hand, a geographical location within the village of Annot located in low-level mountains (04) and equidistant from the Alpes Maritimes, Alpes de Hautes Provence, Var and Bouches de Rhône. And on the other hand, it has high quality infrastructure and equipment which distinguishes it from other existing establishments:

Balneotherapy, psychomotor therapy room, bathrooms fully adapted for people with reduced mobility, lift, disabled access across the entire site, landscaped garden, therapeutic vegetable garden, audio and video equipment, leisure equipment, etc.

La Maison d'Amélie is more than a holiday home, it is a real centre that works on socialisation through kindness of the village where it is based. But it is also a tool to work on developing independence and education, without forgetting its main objective: to be a centre offering unique restful holidays

As in previous years, specialised institutes and charities in the disability sector came with their usual supervisory staff. The continued presence year after year of the different institutes and charities is a testament to their satisfaction.

A partnership agreement over a five-year period with a major programme of personalised visits to Alpes Maritimes was formalised at the start of the year, in order to be sure of having access to the rooms in the summer season and during the Christmas holidays.

The catchment area for beneficiaries has not changed since the opening; it covers the Principality and the French administrative departments, 04, 05, 06, 06, 13 and 83. It should nevertheless be noted that a charity from Brest now uses the centre.

As an extension to 'La Maison d'Amélie,' 'La Maison Des Copains' has thus made it possible to increase the capacity by adding 20 additional places and a range of new activities: A therapy pool, a large activity room. A boules pitch has also been added in the huge garden.



OPERATIONS

Since 1st July 2018, the charity has two employees who work across the entire centre; First, Mr Marc NITARD, who has been our property manager since 2013, on a part-time basis, then became full time in October 2014. He is joined by Ms Véronique FREZIA, hired on 1st July 2018 on a part-time basis.

This latest recruitment makes it possible to manage the residents and the accommodation during the busy periods (summer and Christmas holidays)

It has now proven to be essential given the opening of La Maison des Copains.

Since 2015, La Maison d'Amélie has achieved budgetary independence for all its operating costs and overheads: employees and payroll, insurance, telecommunication costs, various maintenance contracts, electricity and consumables.

This independence was still true in 2018, three months after opening 'La Maison des Copains.' This independence is due exclusively to the rental income.

In 2018, this income amounted to €65,815.60 In 2017, it stood at €53,811 in 2017. Since January 2018, the price per night/person has been fixed at 27 euros, as for the previous year.

This growth is mainly due to a marked increase in bookings, with an occupation rate now standing at 30%. Thus, the number of overnight stays recorded for 2018 amounted to 2,604, of which 282 concerned 'La Maison des Copains.' In 2017, it was 1,993 and 1,682 in 2016. The forecast for 2019 is 2,700 overnight stays.

As with previous years, the occupation rate reached 100% in the months of June, July and August as well as during the Christmas holidays. As in previous years, the charity was forced to turn away some bookings.

The occupancy rate remains relatively low for the months of October, November, January, February and March. Nevertheless, a slight improvement was noted for these winter months.

MonacoDiseasePower has stepped up its communication efforts for the autumn and winter periods, focussing on the diverse range of accessible activities: rambling, cycling, snow activities including walks with snow shoes, sledging or skiing.



AND THAT'S NOT ALL

Like last year, Monaco Disease Power helped fund 10 visits over the year for a total cost of €10,000 to help young people suffering from mental disability and/or autism, some of whom live in difficult family situations.

These stays were funded through specific donations made by faithful donors, for that purpose. The partnership created with Monaco's social services continues and deepens year after year.

The charity had to manage an exceptional situation this year, in welcoming a young adult over a period of three consecutive months. For people and family who want to be accompanied during their holidays, they can contact Améliberté, a company created in January 2014, that provides services to disabled people; it is managed by Ms Elodie Chemama, a special needs teacher.

Améliberté is a company on a human scale which provides the means for people to go on tailor made holidays, in small groups and can provide individual care if necessary. It meets a need in terms of personalised stays for disabled people.

By working with Améliberté, Monaco Disease Power makes it possible for:

- parents to send their children on holiday, with complete peace of mind.
 - provide personalised, safe care, so that people can enjoy a holiday
 - help families holidaying at the Maison d'Amélie, by offering educational assistance to their children during their stay.
 - offer holidays based on a specific theme in the form of 'transfer to open custody' to a group of residents.
- At the centre, the staff are also fully available and want to listen to the residents' needs in order to make their holidays as enjoyable as possible.







Holidays and breaks at La Maison d'Amélie



In a nurturing environment, the charity has put in place a set of structural, and human resources to foster the wellbeing of disabled people, as well as their families.

Thanks to the wonderful location, we are able to offer a wide range of activities tailored to each person depending on their needs and abilities, both in winter and in summer: paddle boating on the lake and along the river, swimming pool, horse riding, rock climbing, rambling, snow activities (sledging, snow shoes), visiting villages, train rides, cultural visits and the various festivals at different times of the year.

A wide range of different activities are organised to help relax and educate focussing on everyday actions and gestures: Manual and psychomotor therapy activities, agility games in the garden and the therapeutic vegetable garden, cooking and barbecue workshops in the summer kitchen, as well as relaxing activities such as the balneotherapy.

For people and families who want to be accompanied and supported during their stay, they can call on Améliberté, a charity created in January 2014 and managed by Ms Elodie Chemama, special needs teacher. Améliberté is a company on a human scale which enables people to take tailor made holidays, in small groups and can provide individual care if necessary. It meets a need in terms of personalised holidays for disabled people.

Thanks to being fully integrated in the village of Annot, and the warm welcome given to the residents of the charity, we have been able to make real progress in terms of socialisation, autonomy and independence. Other than leisure activities, La Maison d'Amélie is also a real educational tool which supplements the daily care provided by special needs organisations.



THE PROJECT

La Maison d'Amélie, with a floor area of 500m² and a capacity of 20 people, was opened in 2013 and very quickly, requests started pouring in. The feedback and testimonials from residents confirmed that this new centre meets a real need for high-quality restful holidays, so vital to the specific needs of various disabilities. Quite soon, La Maison d'Amélie had to refuse booking requests, but also it changed its focus: now it is more than a holiday home, it is a true educational and social support tool.

The quality of the construction work and the range of on-site activities makes it unique and it very quickly became clear that the project needed to expand and add the La Maison des Copains.'



CONSTRUCTION

Construction work on 'La Maison des Copains' therefore began in July 2017, and was completed in October 2018 with the voluntary help of Mr Christian Curau, architect, the development was designed over two separate buildings with a total floor area of 550m²;

The first building is to accommodate 16 people, the second, 'La Récré' was planned for activities. La Récré therefore houses a therapy pool and a large activity room equipped with audio and video facilities and a pottery oven.

'L'appart,' family 3-room accommodation completes the property development and therefore brings the capacity to 40 people. The garden was made larger in order to include a boule pitch. The total cost of this project was 2 million euros.

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
